

How to access CCN reading lists on the Library website as an external user


When you see the screen below, click on 'Guest'.




To view HE course reading lists, first click on 'Dashboards' and select 'CCN Norfolk House Home' or 'Easton College Home' from the drop down, depending on which site the course you are interested in is taught at.




Once you have selected the site you will be studying at, click on 'Quick Lists'. This will bring up a drop down of all the module reading lists for courses taught at that site. Scroll through the list to find the module reading list you are looking for.



Click on the reading list to view the list of physical books available for that module. Below, you can see the reading list page for the module 'M2602 – Media, Crime and Deviance'.




By clicking on the title of a book on the list, you will be able to see further information about it, including a description, publishing information, and availability in the library.



Search the Catalogue


You may also wish to browse other books in our collection. You can type keywords, book titles, author names or ISBNs into the search bar:



Once you've typed in your search term, you can either click the 'search' icon, or select a particular field to search within e.g. keywords.



Once you have pressed the search button, you can use the filter options in the side bar to narrow down the results by campus, media format, genre and more.
